Whether it's fitting insulation, installing energy efficient air source heat pumps or providing expert advice to shrink your fuel bills, we want to help you live in a warmer home and reduce the energy you use. By making your home more energy efficient you'll be able to keep warm for less, and you'll be helping reduce the county's carbon footprint on the way to Net Zero by 2030.

Who's it for?

Home owners who have a gross income (from all sources) of less than £30,000 can get grants to help insulate and heat their property. Private tenants who meet the same criteria can also get help. Landlords with qualifying tenants can receive a two-thirds grant towards the cost of making energy-saving improvements. And anyone can get in touch with us for energy-saving advice or a benefit check. We particularly want to hear from people whose homes have the lowest energy rating of D, E, F or G.

Home Owners

If your home doesn't give you a warm welcome any more then we can help, with grants and advice to reduce your energy bills.

Renters

Warm Homes Suffolk isn't just for home owners - if you're a private tenant then you could be eligible for help to heat the home that you rent more efficiently.
